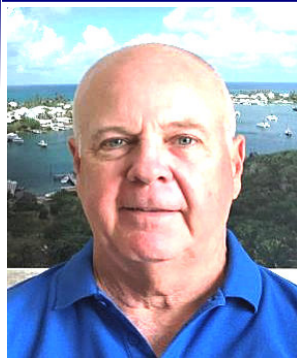

The board has been approved the 2020 FBYC operating budget. This included holding a special meeting on Feb. 6th solely focused on the budget. We have developed a fiscally prudent budget which includes a little belt sighting for reasons explained below.

Approximately three quarters of our budget goes to fixed costs, storage space, internet/web services, liability Insurance, cost for use of the church hall, P.O Box, AED

maintenance, etc.

Our membership is down from 150 a couple years ago to 131 today. There are now 12 lifetime members that do not pay dues leaving 119 members to pay all of the fixed costs. This leaves a relatively small portion of our budget to spend on activities. Over the last two years we have spent \$3,000 more than we took in. It is not sustainable for long.

This leads me to recruitment. As previously stated, our membership is down from 150 a couple years ago to 131 now. There were 4 boat clubs in Flagler a few years ago including the FBYC. There are only three left and at least one of those nearly folded this year due to aging membership and their failure to attract new members. As we all know, another was forced to sell their building due to aging and declining membership. Over the past couple of years FBYC has not attracted many new members. These other clubs are the future for us if we don't take action now to ensure the FBYC is still viable in 20 years. Joel and I will be leading an effort to recruit

For our larger vessels, after further inquires, safety of the vessels and tides, we will leave it up to the captain's discretion if they want to dock their vessels at the park. **Maritime Tips:** Extra tips we may have forgotten

**Florida Recreational Boating Requirements:** Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Comm

**Life Preservers:** We all know all recreational vessels must carry on board at least one wearable-type life jacket for each person on your vessel. Also, 16 feet or greater (except canoes and kayaks) must carry one Type IV throwable preserver.

While on Florida waters, children under six years of age must wear a PFD of proper size while on board a vessel under 26 feet in length while underway. "Underway" means any time except when the vessel is anchored, moored, docked. New York state requires all children 11 and younger must wear a USCG approved life jacket while aboard a boat 65 feet in length or less.

I personally wonder why each state has such different requirements, especially when it pertains to children.

**Fire Extinguishers:** All recreational vessels must carry approved fire extinguishers. Vessels less than 26 feet in length, propelled by outboard motors, of open construction which will not permit the entrapment of explosive or flammable capers and not carrying passengers for hire are exempt.

**Sound Producing Devices:** All vessels must carry a whistle or horn. This means it must be capable of producing a constant blast of at least six seconds and audible for at least one-half mile. Vessels 65 ft in length must carry a bell.

**Vessel Registration:** When you buy a vessel, you have 30 days from the date of purchase to have the registration numbers and decal properly displayed. Until your vessel is registered and numbered, or until the registration is changed, you must carry your bill of sale on board.

**Boating Accident Reporting: abbreviated version:** When there is personal injury requiring treatment beyond immediate first aid, death, disappearance, damage to the vessel of at least \$2,000, Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, and/or the Sheriff of the county must be notified.

### Boat US Members:

Free on line Boating Safety Courses. There are also paid course that can be taken on line. I will be looking at the GPS course for a nominal fee, I will let you know how it is. 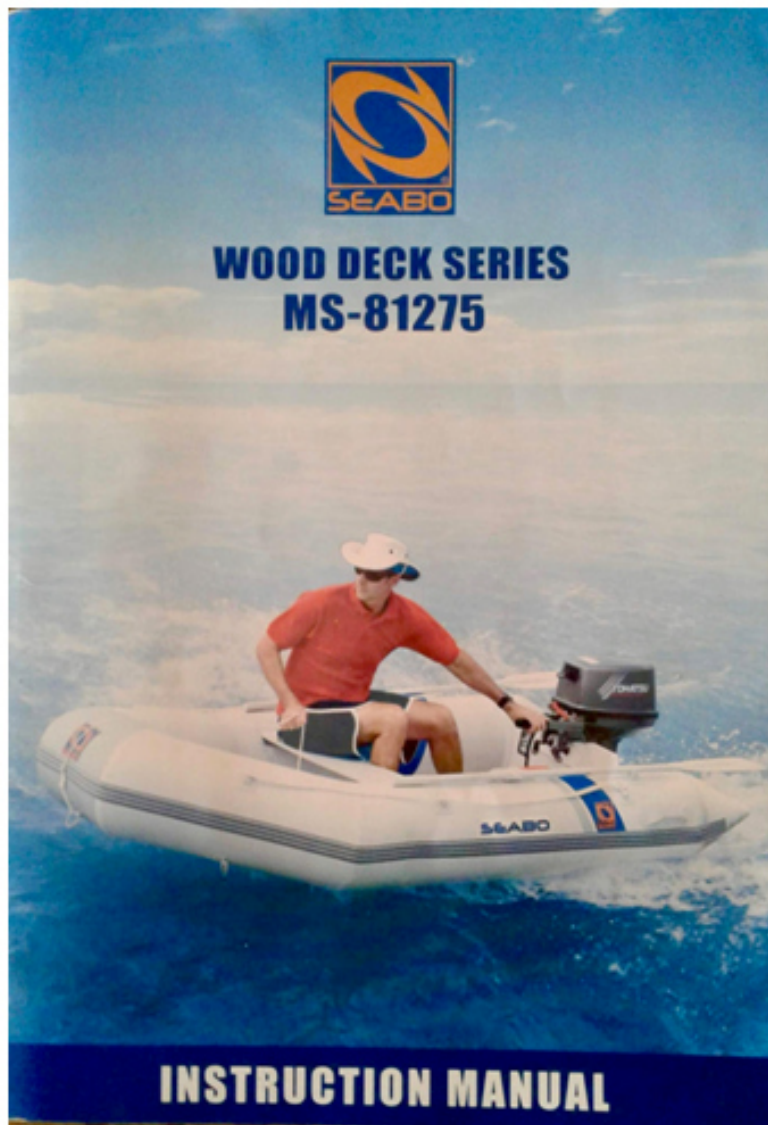


