

## Maritime Moments

Ahoy to our members and friends!

The Treasure Hunt that was organized by the Basany family was fun and challenging. We had a total of 5 participants and 7 vessels attended the raft up. The winning vessel was NautiLady, Captained by Anne Smith. The first place prize was a Nautical Brass Antique Telescope. The second place was won by Jerry Imbriani and crew. Jerry won a flamingo design plastic wine glass set.

For our new members, when we have "raft ups" usually at Cimmaron basin, we attach the vessels together to form a row. You will need extra lines, fenders and an anchor and a bit of patience. If you know you have to leave earlier than others, please advise me so I can have you on an end spot. We will have one or two "anchor vessels" which are the largest and depending on how many we have participating, every 3rd vessel will drop an anchor. The timing is important because I will direct you by VHF Radio on channel 68, bull horn or cell phone, when it is your turn to tie up. Vessels will be in size order, largest will anchor first and then the vessels according to size will be positioned on either sides. Please standby by until you are called.

Slow Speed May 1 - September 7




