SAFETY

Greetings again, I usually insert articles about maintenance or safety here but this month I would like to say a few things about some things that have happened on the waters lately. I'm sure everyone is tired of me talking about safety, but it is something that I am passionate about and think everyone should be aware of. There have been several accidents this past month on the water. Some local, some that happened in other parts of the state. You might have heard of a few but probably not all. The biggest one that happened here locally was the accident at Matanzas. That accident ended with one fatality and two people hospitalized. The FWC put out a preliminary report that didn't give a lot of detail, but I would encourage everyone to look it up and read it. It doesn't take much for things to go wrong on the water and the faster the boat is going the faster things go wrong and less time to react. (Especially when adult beverages are involved). On the other end of the speed spectrum, I heard of an accident recently that involved a boat and a dock. A boat was going down a canal and the captain was texting and ran right into a dock, not one he planned on stopping at. As far as I am aware no one was hurt and there was minimal damage but none the less it could have been worse. So, my main point here is be smart, cautious, and aware. I'd hate to read or get informed any of our members where in a serious accident.

The other side of my safety talk and of the incidents that happened this pertains to first aid and medical issues. This accident happened in the gulf on the west coast of Florida and isn't a huge concern here, but similar situations could happen. The incident I am talking about is a young lady (teenager) was snorkeling and got bit by a shark. (Again, not likely in the canals). Luckily her brother responded and was able to administer First Aid. He also used his marine VHF Radio (I believe I've talked about this a few times) to call for help. While she sustained some serious wounds, she is still alive. I will finish this up with a couple things. While it is not required to carry a first aid kit on your boat, I would highly recommend it. You never know when you might need it. Yes, I agree a shark attack is a bit extreme, but Prop's and oyster shells can do just as much damage. Oh, and a VHF isn't a bad idea either.

If anyone is interested in a First Aid class, please let mem know. If I get enough people interested, I can see about scheduling a class.
